As a wrap-up for the ELK Year which ended on March 31, 2010, we are happy to report that we were, once again, significant contributors to the Hudson Valley Region Special Olympics volunteer program. For that period, and through the eight events in which we provided volunteers and services, our total contributions were as follows:

85 Elks and **58 Helpers** volunteered their services.

The Volunteers logged a total of **713 hours** of time to the program and;

They travelled a total of **3480 miles** to complete their tasks.

The Lodge Donated **\$750 in cash** and distributed **\$1650 in non-cash** contributions.
